

## **DVOA & Quail Hill Scout Club Invitational Orienteering meet - Quail Hill Scout Camp, Manalapan, NJ - 15<sup>th</sup> event in the Garden State Scout O Series**

Delaware Valley Orienteering Association (DVOA) will host on Sunday 18 Oct 2009, a Scout Map Hike with assistance from Monmouth Council and Central Council BSA volunteers

**Costs** \$7.00 per Scout / Scout Leaders/adults (but adult fee is waived if the Scout leaders are hiking along for safety). First come first served 2009 Orienteering Scout patches, included in entry fee. Girl Scouts, Boy and Cub Scouts, Leaders & siblings are welcome to participate in this Map-Hike.

White and Yellow (Scouts and beginners) regular orienteering course, Orange intermediate difficulty O course & Green difficult (for adults) course - Scouts must hike or run courses in **teams** of 2 or 3. Adult leaders are welcome to test their map-hike skills on the Orange or Green courses. -Note: NEW revised color topographical map, 2.5 meter contours, 1:5000 scale. Basic Orienteering Instruction available upon request. Please bring along one compass per team, we have limited rental compasses. Cub Scout adult leader escorts accompany the team with no additional fee. **Starts** are between 10:15 am to 1:00 pm Courses should be completed in 45 minutes to 1 1/4 hour (Or more) depending on the Scouts level of hiking and map reading experience. **Awards** will be issued via mail to the top 3 teams on each course. Scout Teams try to locate certain parts of the camp or forest, using trails when useful, in the order identified on the Orienteering course clue sheets and the topo Map they will receive. Standard Orange/White Orienteering flags are used.

**Safety Caution.** All Drivers and leaders are to caution the Scouts that the Orienteering courses may have two camp-road crossings. Please remind Scouts to look both ways before crossing any camp roads and to watch for vehicles. Drivers are asked to observe the 10 MPH speed limit while in camp.

**Preregistration Is Required:** if 4 or more Scouts from your troop/pack may attend please email your Troop/Pack # and details to the meet director 2 help in the O meet planning & so we can reserve your own Scout maps. The organizers will assign you a Start or "Show up" appointment, please specify if you want an early or late time, and arrive at the registration table within +/-15 minutes of that time for an expedited registration and team start. \$10 Registration deposit requested.

Directions: Quail Hill Main entrance at the end of Le Valley Drive. The main parking lots straight past the main entrance are too small to handle much traffic. In any event, all drivers should look for red and white arrows directing you to the proper parking area. Of historical interest, Monmouth Battlefield state park is a 1/2 hour hike or a 12 minute drive to the East, on NJ state Route 33. Please car pool.

Event is limited to First 200 Scouts to register.

The registrar reserves the right to adjust late registering units start times to spread out the arrival of cars in the camp parking lot. Please car pool as much as possible and do not park in the camps fire lanes. Picnic benches are available at the registration area (the New Pima picnic site), please feel free to bring a bag lunch. If your unit is camping the weekend at the camp, please mention that to the registrar.
