

# **LA Bass Cats 2005 invitational - Bass Tournament Rules Cabot Landing - February 13, 2005, \$1000 1<sup>st</sup> place**

- 1. All state and federal laws must be obeyed.**
- 2. Entry fee is \$100.00 per boat(2 people per boat).**
- 3. Blast-off and weigh-in will be at Cabot Landing.**
- 4. All teams must check-in prior to blast-off, obtain a blast-off number and a boat marker.**
- 5. Blast-off order will be determined by picking a number as payment is received.**
- 6. Tournament hours will be from safe daylight to 3pm. All contestants must be in weigh-in line by 3pm.**
- 7. A limit of 5 fish per team will be weighed, measuring a minimum of 14 inches or greater, no courtesy checks.**
- 8. There will be a 4 ounce penalty for each dead fish.**
- 9. All fish must be taken with rod and reel on artificial lures, trolling is not permitted.**
- 10. In the event of a tie, big bass breaks big stringer tie and big stringer breaks big bass tie.**
- 11. This is a catch and release tournament, all fish should be returned to the water asap, all Dead fish will be retained by the club.**
- 12. No more than 5 fish will be allowed in the live well at weigh-in.**
- 13. All boats should have working running lights and a kill switch.**
- 14. No contestant is allowed to fish within 50 yards of a competing boat that is tied or anchored unless permission is granted.**
- 15. All contestants must wear a coast guard approved life vest while the main engine is in gear.**
- 16. Interpretation and enforcement of all rules will be the sole responsibility of the LA Bass Cats Board of Directors. Any protest must be made within 15 minutes of the last weigh-in and must be in writing.**
- 17. All boats must have liability insurance.**
