MOVE-UP REGULATIONS: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made in writing via postal mail or email to the trial secretary only. Move-ups for Saturday, August 29th must be received not later 6:00 p.m. on Monday, August 24th. Day to day move-ups will be accepted, and must be received by the awarding of the last ribbon of the day. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class. *Move-ups are not allowed from Novice A to Novice B after the closing date of this trial.*

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: No more than 10 entries allowed per envelope. No online entries will be accepted. Express mail entries must waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Trial secretary assumes no responsibility for incorrect entry information due to illegibility of the entry. Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on entry forms with the AKC agreement printed on the reverse side. Any entry not compliant with the above will be returned!

Notification of entry status will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. Trial secretary is not responsible for emails returned due to illegible email addresses, full mailboxes, spam blockers or any other event causing email to be returned or missed, and no further effort will be made. Any exhibitor requiring to know their entry status before final confirmations are sent should send a SASE or postcard to be returned with that information. No other notification of entry status will be made. Final entry confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter1, Section18 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing an email address will be emailed their confirmations. Exhibitors with no email address or with email addresses that have bounced their entry status will be sent their confirmation via the US Postal Service.

Partial refunds after the closing date will be allowed for bitches in season and injured dogs. Request for refund must be made in writing, before judging begins, and accompanied by notice from a veterinarian. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring.

The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts between rings should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs and yourselves.

These clubs do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

CATALOGS: Catalogs will be available by presale. If you would like a catalog, circle "Catalog" on your entry form and include \$10.00 in addition to your entry fees. A limited number of catalogs will be available the weekend of the trial. Running orders will be available to all exhibitors at no charge.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges or approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. All dogs entered will receive their choice of a toy or bag of treats, regardless of whether they qualify. Dog and handler teams earning their MACH or PAX title will receive a special title rosette, and dog and handler teams earning their MACH will also receive a decorated jump bar. New title ribbons will also be available to any dog completing a title. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. No ribbons or prizes will be mailed.

CLASSES: All Standard and Jumpers with Weaves. There will be no ISC, FAST or non-regular classes at this trial. Electronic timers will be used at this event.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION: Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class following the judges briefing. The walk-through may be split at the judges discretion.

MEASURING: Exhibitors must present their height card at check in. All dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary jump height card issued by the AKC must be measured by one of the VMOs scheduled to be present at this trial. Any dog that runs without being measured will have all qualifying scores revoked.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

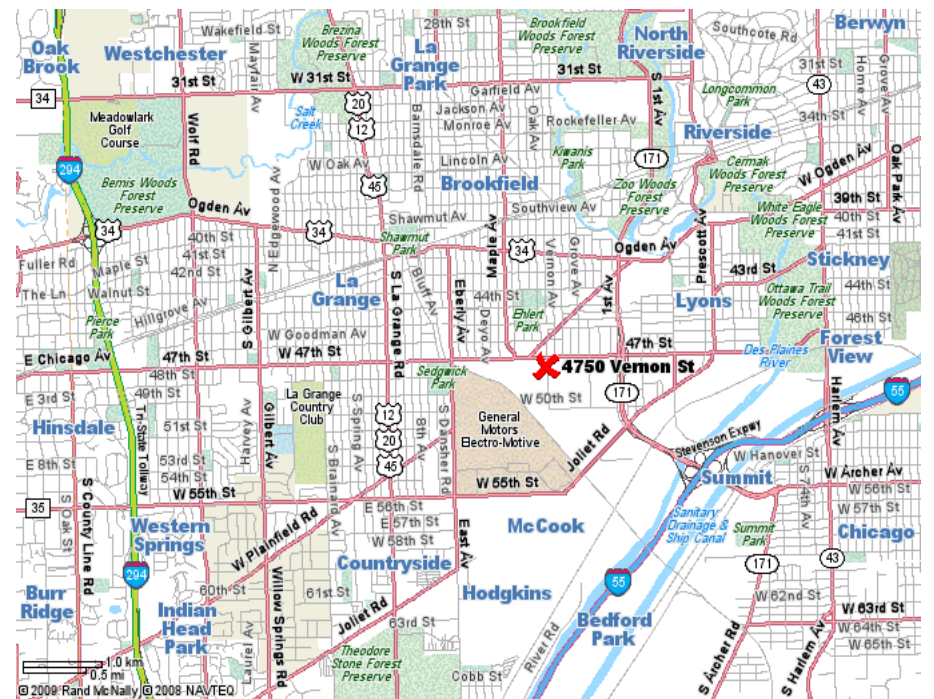
Directions to the site are as follows:

From northbound or southbound I-294, exit at Ogden Avenue East. Go east on Ogden for 2.6 miles to East Avenue and turn right (south). Go south on East Avenue for .8 miles and turn left (east) on 47th Street. Go .8 miles on 47th Street to Vernon and turn right (south).

From I-55, exit at IL171 North. Continue north on IL171 for 1.2 miles. Take the 47th Street ramp and go left (west) onto 47th Street. Stay on 47th for .8 miles to Vernon and turn left (south) onto Vernon.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative or a Volunteer Measuring Official prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
