Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Please do not use staples to attach checks and/or height cards to your entry! Checks returned due to non sufficient funds will be assessed a \$25 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms, or those with insufficient entry fees, will be returned, no attempts by email or phone will be made!

Notification of entry status will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. Trial secretary is not responsible for emails returned due to illegible email addresses, full mailboxes, spam blockers or any other event causing email to be returned or missed, and no further effort will be made. Any exhibitor requiring to know their entry status before final confirmations are sent should send a SASE or postcard to be returned with that information. No other notification of entry status will be made. Final entry confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 18 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing an email address will be emailed their confirmations, exhibitors with no email address will be sent their confirmation via the US Postal Service.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Indefinite Listing Privileges or approved FSS breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

MEASURING: All dogs that do not have a permanent or valid temporary jump height card issued by the AKC and jumping other than 24 or 26 inches must be measured by the judge of record prior to competing. You may submit a copy of your height card with your entry in order to expedite check-in the day of the trial. If a copy is not received, exhibitors must present the official card at check-in or the dog will have to be measured by the judge prior to running in any class. If an AKC representative or VMO is scheduled to be present at this trial, all dogs, regardless of their jump height, not having an AKC height card must be measured prior to competing.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

CLASSES: Novice Standard, Jumpers with Weaves and FAST titling classes will be offered. There will be no Open or Excellent titling, ISC or non-regular classes at this trial. Electronic timers will be used at this event.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes and prizes. No awards will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. Bitches that come into season after the closing date and injured dogs may have their entry fee returned, less an administrative fee, by providing the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour before judging begins. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for this event.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. Conflicts between rings should be discussed with the judge prior to the start of the class and the gate steward notified.

Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

CATALOGS/RUNNING ORDERS: Running orders will be available each day to all exhibitors. Full catalogs will be available by presale, with a limited number on hand for sale the day of the trial. If you would like a catalog, please check the box on your entry form, and include \$10.00 in addition to your entry fee.

SITE INFORMATION: The agility trial will be held at For Your Canine, 2433 United Parkway, Schiller Park, IL. This trial will be held indoors on rubber matting. Indoor crating is allowed, crate mats or other ground cover must be used underneath all crates. Dogs must be walked in the designated exercise areas.

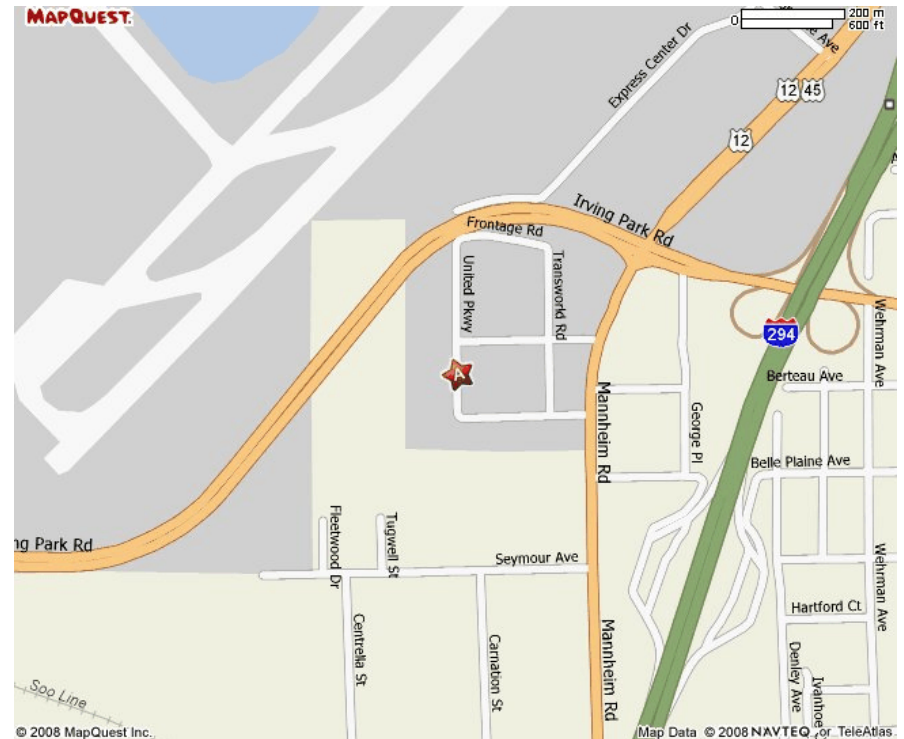
DIRECTIONS:

Directions to the site are as follows:

From the north: I-294 south, exit at Irving Park Road west (stay in the right cash lanes of the toll plaza). Turn left at the first light, Mannheim Road (also Rt 12/45), then take the first right, Delta Parkway. Go through the stop sign, then turn in the last drive before United Parkway. This will be the parking lot at the back side of the building, and the entrance is also on this side.

From the south: I-294 north to I-290 west. Exit from I-290 at North Avenue (Rt. 64) and go east. Take North Avenue east to Mannheim Road (Rt 12/45) north. The entrance to Mannheim Road from North Avenue will be on the right side. Head north on Mannheim Road until you reach United Parkway, then turn left. Follow United Parkway around to the right to Delta Parkway. Turn right on Delta Parkway and then turn right into the first drive. This is the parking lot on the back side of the building and the entrance is also on this side.
