



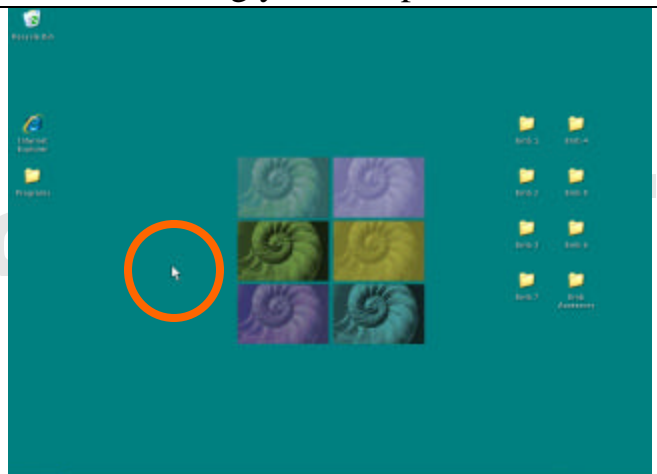
## *A Stitch in Time – Embroidery*

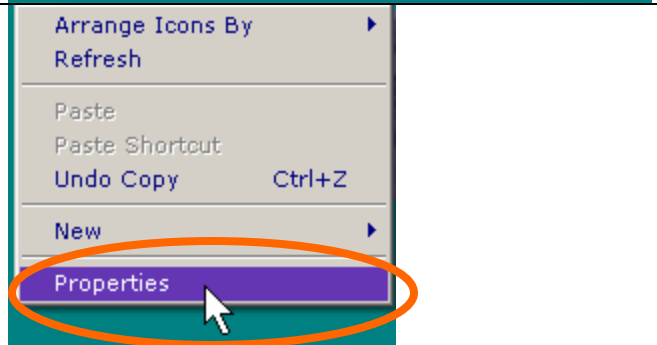
Turn your computer monitor into a digital picture frame

Love the idea of a digital picture frame but don't have room for one more item on your desk? Turn your computer monitor into a picture frame so that it will display your photos when you are not using your computer.

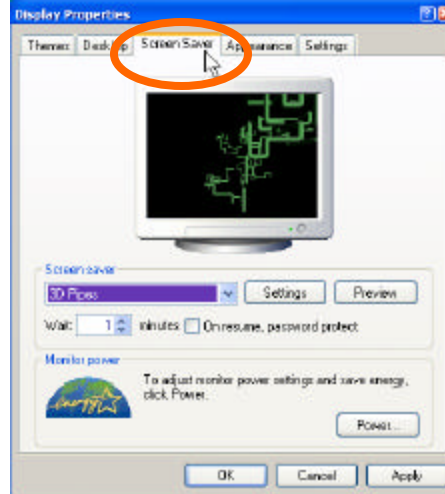
Right click with your mouse button, anywhere on your computer desk top where there is “blank” space (example, not where you have icons or folders)



From the pop up box, click on the word **PROPERTIES**.

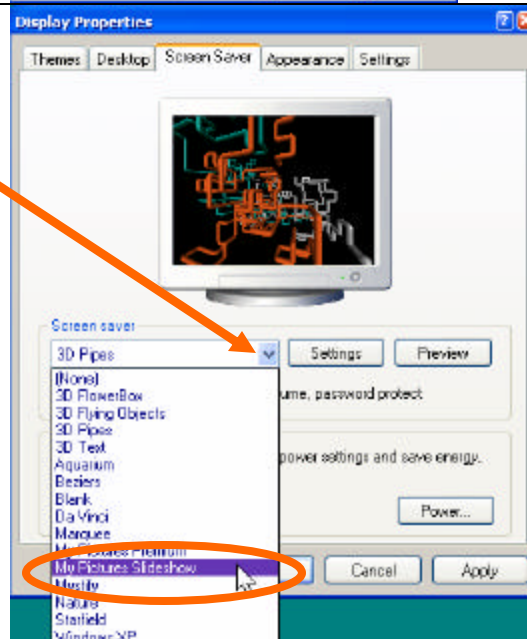


Click on the Screen Saver tab from the **DISPLAY PROPERTIES** dialog box.

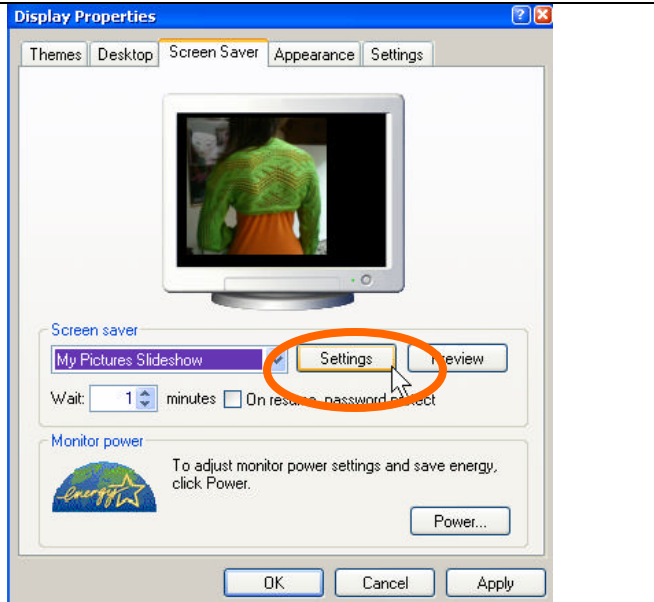


Click on the arrow to open the Screen saver options.

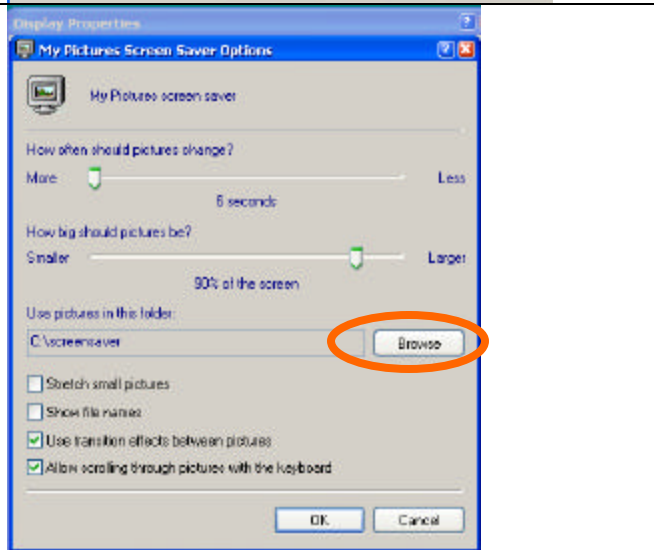
Click on **“MY PICTURES SLIDESHOW”** that will change your screen saver to show your photos.



Click on the “**SETTINGS**” button. This is the area where you will make all your decisions on what folder to choose to use in the slide show, how long to wait until the slide show starts and more.

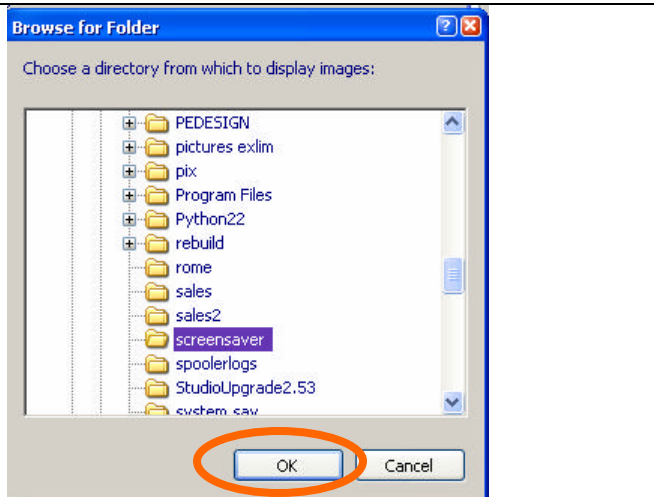


After you click on “Settings”  
The **MY PICTURES SCREEN SAVER OPTIONS** dialog box opens.  
Use the slider to choose how often the pictures should change and how much space on the screen they should use.



Click on the Browse button to choose the location on your hard drive for the screen saver to use.

The **BROWSE FOR FOLDER** dialog window pops up and you have a view of the folders on your computer. In my case, I created a folder called screensaver to put the pictures I wanted to view for my “digital picture frame”. Click on the folder and click **OK**.



The My Pictures Screen Saver Options dialog box is on screen now. You can choose other options for your slide show, play with the options to see if they are what you want and then click OK to save the settings.
