Research Technician, Biology. Project: Breast Cancer Stem Cells

A research technician position is available starting December 2009. The project goal is to identify new markers on breast cancer stem cells. This will serve as the first step towards identifying the role of these cells in breast cancer. Techniques applied are antibody phage display, laser capture microdissection, immunohistochemistry and standard molecular biological and protein biochemical techniques. Knowledge of basic molecular biological, biochemical and cell culture techniques is expected. Specialized techniques will be carried out after training through existing lab members, prior experience in these areas is a plus. Participation in general lab upkeep is also expected. The project is grant funded for 1.3 years.
