## ENTRIES IN PRINCIPLE - DEADLINE APRIL 30, 2007

Send a note (email or fax is best) with your best guess of the names of vaulters, teams and horses from your club intending to participate. It would be helpful if you also indicate any foreign participants which you may be hosting. Foreign vaulters must contact their own FN with their intentions to participate.

## NOMINATED ENTRIES - DEADLINE MAY 30, 2007

*Use Nominated Entries Form 1*

This entry **MUST** list **ALL possible** VAULTERS AND HORSES you wish to enter. For the Team entry, you only must indicate the name of your team (but it would be better if you listed all possible team members. You don't have to pay anything at this time. If a horse or vaulter is not listed on the Nominated Entry (except for Team), that name cannot appear on the Definite Entry. No new names can be added after the Nominated Entry is submitted. You may withdraw names without penalty until you submit the Definite Entry. Foreign vaulters will enter via their FN's but, again, it would be helpful to note any vaulters or team you may be hosting.

## DEFINITE ENTRIES - DEADLINE JUNE 15, 2007 *Use Definite Entries Forms 2, 3, 4, 5 and Payment Form*

This is your final entry indicating the vaulters, horses, teams intending to compete. Complete all required forms and **mail in with payments (made to Cooper-Garrod Estate Vineyards)** to Marianne Rose, 11845 Skyline Blvd., Los Gatos, 95033. You may fax to 408/867-1789.

## HORSES

**If you have any horses capable of top level vaulting and you are willing to bring them to this event (even if your vaulters is not participating),** please contact Emma Seely at 408/868-9476 or [emmaseely@sbcglobal.net](mailto:emmaseely@sbcglobal.net).

Horses must possess a valid FEI Passport OR be registered with the USAE and possess a valid vaccination certificate. Please begin any necessary vaccination programs now. You may find information about USAE Registration and the required forms at [www.equestrian.org](http://www.equestrian.org).

Reminder: All horses competing at the FEI level must have written proof from a veterinarian, who is not the owner of the horse, stating the horse has received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza, given no less than 21 days apart and no more than 92 days apart. In addition, a booster injection must be recorded as having been given within each succeeding 12 months subsequent to the second injection of the primary vaccination. None of these injections may be given less than seven days before the competition, including the day of the competition or of entry into the competition stables.

For those of you with older horses who came to you without their primary inoculation records, this will mean giving your horse a new primary series before your first FEI competition. This is not a new rule, but one that will be strictly enforced in the upcoming competition year.

**HELPFUL HINT:** *FAX ALL YOUR PAPERWORK* TO Dr. Waldsmith () by *June 20, 2007*. He will reply to you with any problems and that will insure an easy vet check for your horses! Bring all your originals to the vet check also.

Horses and participants may arrive at Garrod Farms on Friday, June 27th.

Vet Inspection Friday, June 29th: Horses must be groomed as if for competition and the person handling the horse must be dressed as if for competition. Horses will be trotted in hand before the Veterinarian. Be sure to check USEF Website for drugs and medications information. The Inspection will be from 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm.
