Memorial Scholarship

The Larry Kleiner Memorial Scholarship is made available to the members of IAABO Metro District Board 117 to help defray their expenses so that they may attend basketball camp. Presently there are four scholarships available to members who have not previously received this scholarship.

Larry Kleiner was a longtime member of Board 32 and a charter member of Board 117 in 1987. Larry was a three sport official (basketball, football and baseball) and was well liked by his peers and respected by the coaches.

Larry was leader among officials and he always volunteered to help. He enjoyed officiating and he was dedicated to youth at all levels. Larry was also a mentor to many new officials and helped others to share his enthusiasm for the sport.

Larry officiated his final game in August of 1992 at the Shrine Football Classic. He was diagnosed with cancer shortly after this game and he died in October of 1992.

The members of Board 117 began a very modest scholarship to memorialize Larry and the scholarship has since grown to four individual scholarships.

Requirements

1. The applicant must be a member or dual member of Board 117 in good standing.
 2. The applicant must attend a boys camp during the year in Which the scholarship is granted.
 3. The applicant must not have previously received this scholarship. Previous awards are kept on file.
- * The amount of the scholarship shall not exceed one half of the total cost of attending the camp or a maximum of \$100.
 - * The scholarship is made payable to the member upon successful completion of the camp and furnishing a receipt to the Board.
 - * The scholarship is not based solely on need.
 - * The scholarship and the number of scholarships awarded are done so at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
