## **DeKalb LEPC to Hold April Meeting**

The DeKalb County Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) will hold its next quarterly meeting on Monday, April 17, 2006, 6:30 p.m. at the DeKalb County Highway Department Building, 1826 Barber Greene Road, DeKalb. The LEPC holds meetings in the conference room on the west end of that building.

All LEPC meetings are open to the public. The LEPC encourages attendance by anyone interested in its activities.

Established by the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, the LEPC plans quick responses to possible releases of hazardous materials within the county. Details about the LEPC, its membership and its activities can be found on its website:

The agenda for the LEPC meeting includes a call to order; roll calls of officers, members and guests; introductions; and a determination if a quorum is present. The meeting then proceeds with approval of minutes from the preceding meeting, a report on LEPC membership changes if needed, and reports from the Secretary/Treasurer and Chair. Members highlight any upcoming training opportunities, conferences or conventions that may be of interest. The meeting concludes with a roundtable discussion by LEPC members and an opportunity for members of the general public to comment or ask questions.
