Parents are as always, welcome to attend, and drivers **will** be needed to transport Scouts. We will be going to Camp Butler, in Peninsula, for one night of outdoor camping. We have reserved 5 Adirondacks at the Chittenden site. Come join the activities surrounding our annual Polar Bear campout. We'll drive out Saturday morning, arrive in time to setup camp, make lunch, spend the afternoon hiking around, working on needed advancements, make dinner and enjoy a crisp Winter Night under the stars. We'll have breakfast on Sunday morning, break camp and drive home. Food will be provided by the troop, but all cooking will be done by Patrol.

Make sure to dress warmly and to bring your outdoor weather gear. With a bit of planning and work you will be able to complete all the requirements and earn your **Polar Bear Patch**. One of the patch requirements is that you spend 18 consecutive hours outdoors. Another requirement is that you hike at least the last half mile to your campsite with all your gear packed.

The cost for this camp out will be **\$15.00** per Scout, and all participating adults are **free!** Please turn in your permission slips and fees as soon as possible. Remember all adults are welcome at no additional cost.

I give permission to the leaders of the above unit to render First Aid, should the need arise and or to secure other medical treatment, as needed. I further agree to hold the above named unit and its leaders blameless for any accidents that might occur during this outing.
