

# IMPORTANT

Dear Homeowner and/or Tenants:

It has come to the attention of the Town Council that, due to a wetter than normal spring season, there is a heavy growth of grass and weeds in the Town. The big problem is the area between back fences and the asphalt in the alley, which people do not notice because they are not in the alley often. Many back and side yards are neglected too, which may be a potential fire hazard.

In accordance with Town Ordinances, weeds and grass are to be cut to a height of less than four (4) inches. Weeds and grass that are not properly cut will be subject to citing by the Code Enforcement Officer. Failure to act on this citation can result in the issuing of a ticket to Municipal Court by the Mountain View Police.

Citizens are also reminded that all vegetation must be kept clear of sidewalk space. This includes tree branches lower than seven (7) feet above the sidewalk, and any bushes or vines that branch over the walk. The same penalty for other vegetation violations applies to this growth.

If you physically cannot cut the vegetation and need help, or if you are physically able to lend a helping hand to your neighbor, please call the Town Hall and we will put the two of you together.
