Incidentally, be sure to QNZ when the NCS requests so that you are within the passband of his/her receiver.

#### William Mumford, Cited for Radio Work

William Mumford, retired supervisor at AT&T Bell Laboratories in Whippany, died June 19.

Mumford joined Bell Labs in 1930 and did research work on VHF radio propagation. During World War II he

worked on microwave components for RADAR, and later on transcontinental microwave radio relay links. His contributions in the microwave field included filters, directional couplers, wideband coaxial-to-waveguide transducers, helix-to-

waveguide transitions and the gas-discharge noise generator. He held 16 patents and was the coauthor of two books.

A Fellow and Life Member of the IEEE, Mumford received the Institute's Morris E. Leeds Award for meritorious achievement in electrical measurement and was the first recipient of the Microwave Career Award.

After his retirement in 1970, he worked as a microwave safety consultant.

He held a B.A. degree in physics and mathematics from Williamette University.

He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth, of Morris Plains, N.J., a son and a daughter.

SHE IS ALSO INVOLVED IN EASTERN AREA NET, SECOND REGION NET, TRANSCONTINENTAL CORP AND ALL NJ NETS. WHEN ASKED WHEN SHE SLEEPS, BARBARA RESPONDED, "WHAT'S SLEEP?". TRAFFIC HANDLING IS IN MY BLOOD. MY FATHER WAS A TELEX/TELETYPE OPERATOR FOR RCA GLOBAL COMMUNICATIONS, INC. FOR 45 YEARS. I AM EQUALLY AT HOME ON THE GREEN KEYS AS I AM ON THE CW KEY.

NOW THAT YOU KNOW WHO IS WHO ON NJSN, WHAT'S WHAT?? WELL, NJSN MEETS DAILY AT 6:30 PM ON OR ABOUT 3735 KHZ. THE NET IS DIRECTED BY THE NCS AND HIS WORD IS THE WORD OF AUTHORITY WHILE THE NET IS IN SESSION. ANY ACTION THAT THE NCS DIRECTS IS TO BE DONE WITHOUT QUESTION OR COMMENT. IF THE ASSIGNED NCS DOESN'T SHOW UP ON FREQUENCY TRY TUNING AROUND AND LISTEN, LISTEN, LISTEN. IF THE NET HAS NOT STARTED THEN ANYONE CAN AND SHOULD CALL UP THE NET AND ACT AS NCS. WHILE OUR EMPHASIS IS ON NJ STATIONS, WE WELCOME ANYONE FROM ANYWHERE TO QNI, PASS OR RECEIVE TRAFFIC, OR TO TAKE OUR ON-THE-AIR TRAINING COURSE IN TRAFFIC HANDLING. AFTER A NET SESSION, A NET REPORT SHOULD BE SENT TO WA2OPY. THIS QNS REPORT SHOULD BE SENT AS A RADIOGRAM LISTIN THE NUMBER OF QNI, THE TRAFFIC PASSED AND LISTED, THE TIME DURATION OF THE NET AND A LIST OF THE STATIONS THAT CHECKED-IN. TRAINING MESSAGES SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN THE TRAFFIC COUNT. JAN WILL COMPILE THE NET STATISTICS FROM THE QNS REPORTS. A TRAINING REPORT SHOULD BE SENT TO WB2PKG AFTER EACH SESSION BY THE NCS IDENTIFYING WHO SENT WHICH TRAINING MESSAGES TO WHO.

WHEN YOU QNI TO NJSN LISTEN, ASK AND LEARN. WHEN CHECKING INTO NJSN, AS WITH ANY NET, SEND ONE, REPEAT ONE LETTER, NOT A GROUP SUCH AS THE SUFFIX OF YOUR CALL, AS SOME ARE PRONE TO DO. THIS IS CONFUSING TO THE NCS AND OFTEN PREVENTS HIM FROM IDENTIFYING ANY OF THE SINGLE LETTERS SENT BY INDIVIDUALS WISHING TO QNI. REMEMBER, EFFICIENCY, ACCURACY AND THEN SPEED ARE THE WATCHWORDS, GET IT DONE EFFICIENTLY AND CORRECTLY AND MAKE THE NCS'S JOB AS EASY AS POSSIBLE.

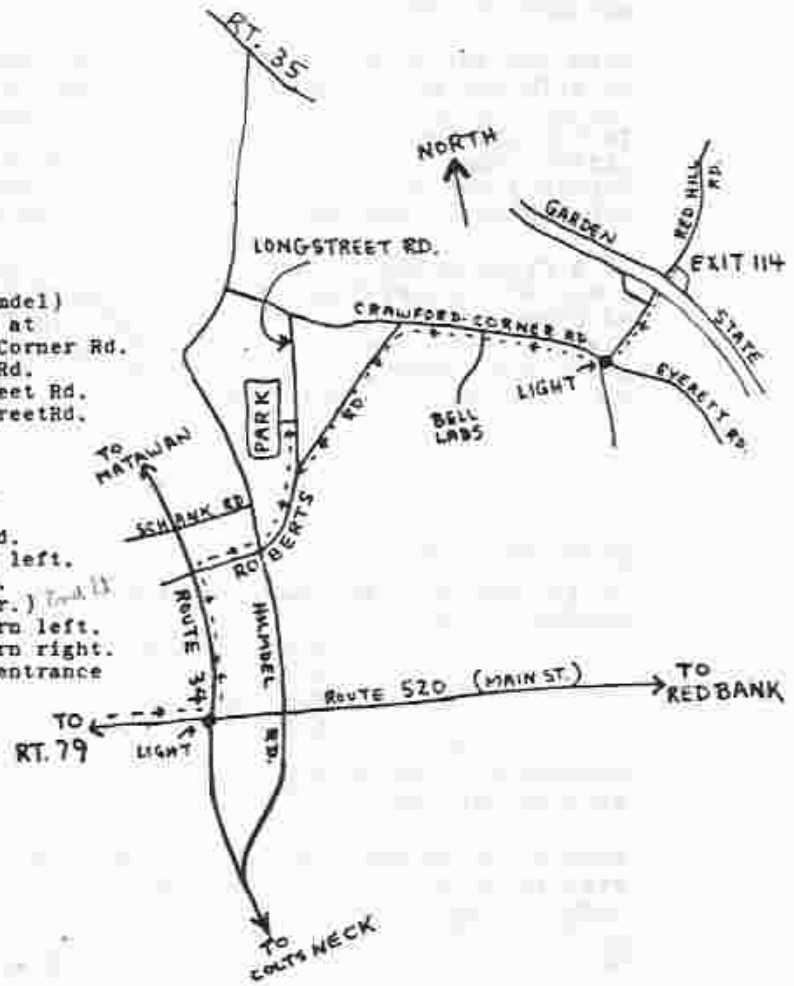

4. Proceed 0.8 mile, turn left on Roberts Rd.
5. Proceed 0.5 mile, turn right on Longstreet Rd.
