

Classic Lotto Facts

As of Oct 31, 2009 there have been 434 Classic Lotto drawings

Consecutive Numbers

There's only a 1 in 317,814 chance that all six of the Classic Lotto numbers will be consecutive numbers. Six consecutive numbers has never happened.

It is a rarity that five (of the six) LOTTO numbers are consecutive numbers, but it did happen on Wednesday, April 11, 2007. They were 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, & 43. There is only a 1 in 8111 chance that that would happen.

Four consecutive numbers were drawn 06/16/08, 20, 35, 39, 40, 41, & 42. Three consecutive numbers has occurred 24 times.

Other Facts

There's a 1 in 104 chance that all six of the Classic Lotto numbers will be even numbers.

There's a 1 in 79 chance that all six of the Classic Lotto numbers will be odd numbers

There is a 1 in 720 chance that the six numbered balls used for the drawing will come out in ascending numerical order. The same thing applies to descending numerical order,

Birth Days

All Birth Days will be between 1 and 31.

There is a 1 in 19 chance that all six Classic Lotto numbers will be between 1 and 31. So far, there have been no drawings where all six numbers were between 1 and 31.

There is a 1 in 4.6 chance that five of six Classic Lotto numbers will be between 1 and 31.

There is a 1 in 2.9 chance that four of six Classic Lotto numbers will be between 1 and 31.

There is a 1 in 3.8 chance that three of six Classic Lotto numbers will be between 1 and 31.

There is a 1 in 9.8 chance that two of six Classic Lotto numbers will be between 1 and 31.

There is a 1 in 52.6 chance that one of six Classic Lotto numbers will be between 1 and 31.

There is a 1 in 753 chance that none of the six Classic Lotto numbers will be between 1 and 31.
