## 1か - 1~7 : はじめまして (How Do You Do?)

### (1か-1: Self Introduction)

1. How do you take attendance?
2. How do you introduce yourself to someone? (e.g. typical one-on-one conversation)
3. How do you introduce yourself when you need to distinguish yourself from somebody else? (e.g. when you are a member of a larger group)

### (1か-2: Japanese Pronunciation)

4. How does the Japanese written language work?
5. How do you identify an object? (It's a "ka.")
6. How do you identify an object - specifying something close to you? (e.g. **This** is a "ka.")

### (1か-3: Greetings)

7. How do you **address** a teacher? (i.e. using respectful title only)
8. How do you **identify** a teacher? (i.e. using both name and title)
9. How do you greet people at different times of day?
10. How do you say goodbye to a teacher? to friends?
11. What is one more way to address someone? (besides "~san" and "~sensei")

### (1か-4: Classroom Expressions)

12. How does a "touban" begin and end class? (3 phrases)
13. What are 7 classroom expressions used by the teacher, touban, and students?
14. How do you ask the identity of something? (i.e. What is it?) ("interrogative" question)
15. How do you ask identity - specifying something close to you? (i.e. What is **this**?)

### (1か-5: Numbers 1 ~ 10)

16. What are the numbers 0-10?
17. How do you ask, tell, and confirm a phone number?
18. What are 9 phrases that can help a conversation to go smoothly?

### (1か-6: Numbers 11 ~ 100)

19. How do you play "Double Digits? (What are the numbers 0-100?)
20. How do you ask the identity of things not close to you? (i.e. What is **that**?) TWO Ways!
21. How do you ask a yes-no question? (e.g. Is this a "ki"?)
22. How do you answer a yes-no question? (e.g. Yes, it is./No, it isn't.) 3 phrases
23. How do you express what something is... or isn't? (e.g. It isn't a "ku.")
24. How do you number pages in a book?
25. How do you ask the page number?

### (1か-7: Weather Expressions)
