“Hajimemashite! (How Do You Do?)” (はじめまして) (Unit 1)

Project Description:

Manga (Comic Book) Booklet OR Poster

- Create a set of 10 comics. (similar to the comics in an American newspaper - may be one or more panels each)
- Organize the comics into a booklet or poster.
- Each comic must identify and answer an aim question from Unit 1

Objectives: *(You should be able to...)*

- Title each comic using an Aim Question taken from the Unit 1 cover page "Daily Aims."
- Use pictures to depict a situation and character(s) appropriate to the aim question and its answer.
- Write the character's speech in Japanese using roomaji (alphabetic romanization).
The Japanese words should be enclosed in comic-style "speech bubbles."
- Include an English translation at the bottom or side of the page -- separate from the main comic.

New York State Performance Standards Addressed:

- Students will be able to use a language other than English for communication.
- Students will develop cross-cultural skills and understandings.

Guidelines:

- Text may be typed, word-processed, or handwritten.
Handwritten work must be in pen - **very** neatly printed and easily legible. NO pencil!
- Aim question is correctly written and clearly placed at the top of each comic.
- Picture demonstrates understanding of the characters and situation appropriate to the aim question.
- Japanese correctly addresses the aim question, is correctly spelled, is placed in a speech bubble, and is easy to read.
- English translation is accurate, correctly spelled, placed at bottom or side of the comic, and is easy to read.
- Overall layout is uncluttered. Text is easy to see and read. (e.g. Avoid writing on dark-colored paper.)
Decorations should not interfere with visibility of text or pictures.

Points Required Written Work/Materials

9010 Comics @ 9 points each:

Aim Question included and accurate. (2 points)

Picture included and accurate. (2 points)

Japanese included and accurate. (3 points)

English included and accurate. (2 points)
