7. Both my older brother and my younger brother are born in America.
(NOUN 1 mo NOUN 2 mo NOUN 3 desu)
8. My older sister is not a college student. My older brother is not a college student either.
(NOUN 1 mo NOUN 2 ja arimasen)
9. Neither my older sister nor my older brother are college students.
(NOUN 1 mo NOUN 2 mo NOUN 3 ja arimasen)
10. My grandfather was a government worker. (NOUN 1 wa NOUN 2 deshita)
11. My father was not a government worker. (NOUN 1 wa NOUN 2 ja arimasen deshita)
