Use roomaji for words that are usually written in katakana.

2nd Year Students: Use kanji and kana only. DO NOT USE ROOMAJI! (or "Redo" will be required!)

1. I watch TV. I read magazines. I listen to the news (OBJECT + o + Action Verb)
2. I eat in the cafeteria. I study in the library. I eat at home. (PLACE + de + Action Verb)
3. I understand a little. He can do it well. I often watch cartoons. (ADVERB + Verb)
4. I watch the news. But, I don't read a newspaper. (SENTENCE 1. Demo, SENTENCE 2)
5. Do you eat sushi? Yes, I do. (Use the same VERB to answer a verb question!)
6. I don't read magazines. I don't eat eggs. I don't drink cola. (OBJECT + wa + Neg. VERB)
7. I ate eggs. I didn't eat bacon. I drank tea. I didn't drink milk. (VERB-mashita, VERB-masen deshita)
8. I didn't eat anything. I didn't drink anything. I didn't see anything. (Nani mo + Neg. VERB)
(NOUN 1 mo NOUN 2 ja arimasen)
9. Yesterday, I played video games. Today, I'll study. (General Time Words + VERB)
10. For breakfast, I eat eggs and toast.. (Meal + ni + VERB)
11. I eat breakfast with my mother. (PERSON + to issho ni + VERB)
12. I eat dinner by myself. (hitori de + VERB)
13. I study. I study Japanese. (NOUN + (o) + shimasu)
14. I study with computer. I do homework with a pencil. (Tool + de + ACTION VERB)
15. At home, my family speaks in Korean. (Language + de + VERB)
