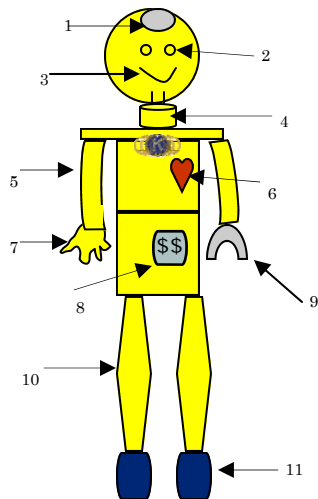

Raffle tickets go unsold; the happy/sad dollar pot holds nothing because these will go unpaid today.

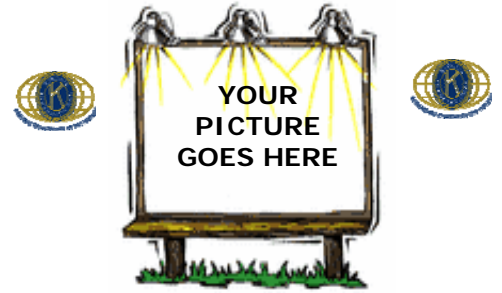
Another good program goes unheard and a club newsletter goes unread.
