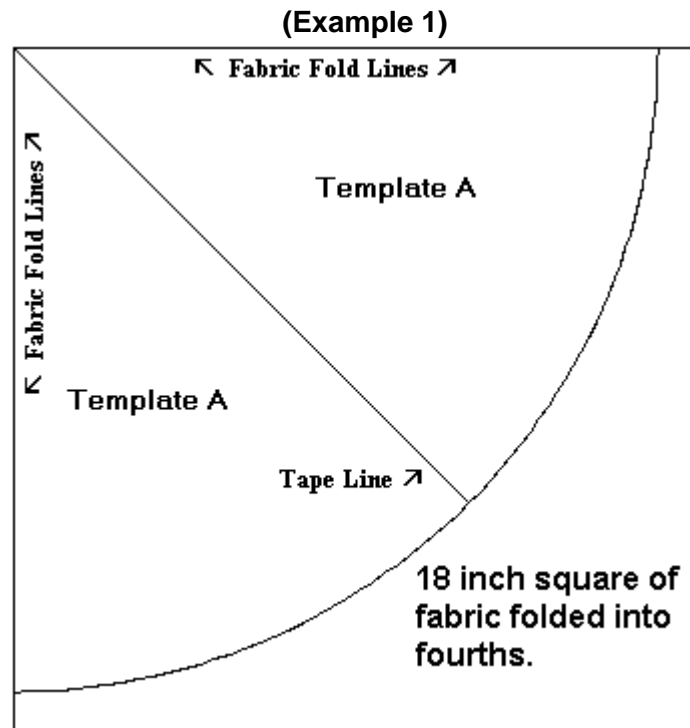


Instructions for Template use by J. Sims

- 1. Print 2 of template A. Tape together lining them up to form a wedge see Example 1.**
- 2. I laminated my templates by putting clear contact shelf paper on both sides then cut it out on the line.**
- 3. Cut an 18 inch square of fabric fold into fourths.**
- 4. Pin template on fabric lining up with the folds and cut around the curved edge.**

Supply's

1 yard of 100% cotton, pre-washed fabric equals 4 napkins.

Instructions:

Cut 1 - 17 inch circle for each napkin, folded it in half and serge the raw edges.

Use gold Wooly Nylon in my upper and lower looper for the rolled hem.

I used Fray Check on the tails and then snipped the tails.

The folding tip!

The folding is the hard part for everyone. Put the half circle so the fold is on my left and then I start folding from the bottom up looking at the picture makes it easier and it worked!
