Description: Incorporate malleable corrugated and compressed fine-silver elements using coordinating wire-wrapped seed pearls and beads while learning the basics of the metal corrugation process. Leave the class with a delicate necklace inspired by the beautiful sea fan.

Description: Create a contemporary fine- and sterling silver bead while learning a new technique. This bead, inspired by the coiled egg casing of the Channel Whelk mollusk, appears complicated but does not require soldering to complete!
